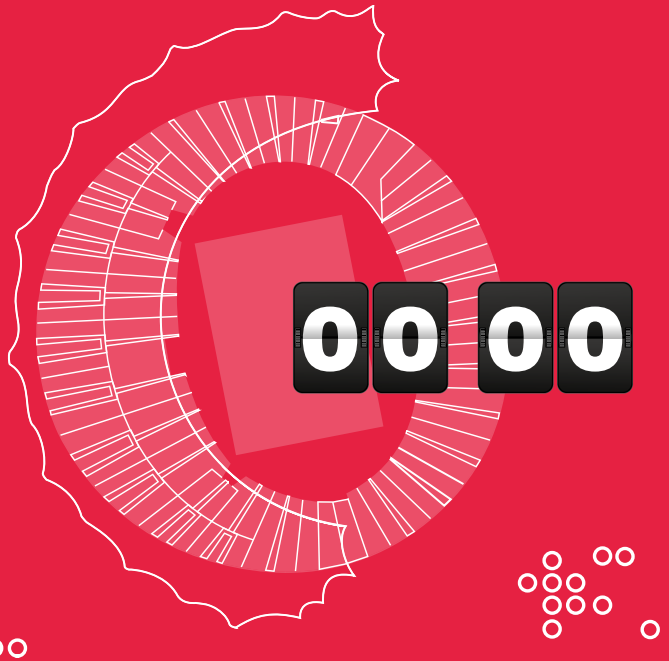


# STOP THE CLOCK

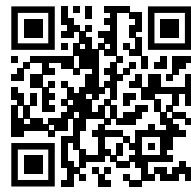

## OUR INITIATIVE

### OUR WAY TO A BID FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES

**Olympic and Paralympic Games** continue to inspire people all over the world. With a modern approach and adapted to the host's circumstances, they can deliver added value for society that goes far beyond sport.

The **German Olympic Sports Confederation (DOSB)** too is pursuing this goal **with its dialogue initiative YOUR IDEAS. YOUR GAMES**, which was launched in **July 2023**.

In a **dialogue with sport, politics, business and industry and, above all, society**, the first step was to develop a representative picture of society's expectations regarding a possible bid. It was shown: **The majority of Germans are in favour of hosting the Games. But not at all costs.**

The findings of the various dialogue formats and discussions were summarized into seven demands in the **Frankfurt Declaration**. These form **the societal guidelines** for the DOSB for the **creation of a bid concept**.

Together with **cities, states and the federal government**, a concept is now being developed that has the **greatest prospects of success nationally and internationally** and best meets society's expectations.

### FRANKFURT DECLARATION

#### IMPETUS FOR THE ENTIRE COUNTRY:

The Olympic and Paralympic Games must provide impetus for a modern, diverse and open Germany and offer added value for as many people as possible.

#### MAXIMUM SUSTAINABLE GAMES:

Ecological, social and economical: An application must be supported by a detailed sustainability concept.

#### ADDED VALUE FOR SPORTS IN GERMANY:

Through the Games, a master plan must be developed that pools the forces in German sport at the top and across the board so that the challenges of the future can be tackled together and in a targeted manner.

#### LONG-TERM PARTICIPATION AND VOICE IN THE PROCESS:

We are developing a modern concept that ensures the permanent and transparent participation of the population – from the initial planning to the extinguishing of the fire.

#### SOUND PLANNING AND PREVENTION OF EXCESSIVE COSTS TO BE COVERED AT THE EXPENSE OF TAXPAYERS:

Constant cost awareness and transparency must be at the centre of economic planning. The budget determines the planning, not the other way round.

#### GAMES FOR THE ENTIRE COUNTRY:

Delivering the Games in one region and several locations enables short travel distances and the avoidance of large new buildings.

#### MAJORITY CURRENTLY IN FAVOUR OF HOSTING GAMES IN SUMMER:

The focus is on a bid for the next Olympic Games of 2036 or 2040.
